#### 3. Architectural Drawings & Shovel Ready

ACES was pleased with the recent designs regarding the front windows on the building to shade the lobby from the evening sunset.

Peter showed ACES Gregory McClung's next set of fees and services so that the project can become shovel ready. The remaining total cost of Stage 1 is \$155,725.00 and would cover architectural services, structural engineering design development, mechanical engineering design development, electrical engineering design development, speciality theatre lighting consultant, specialty acoustical engineering, interior design development and specialty theatre seating consultant. The stage 2 cost would be \$618,780.00 and would cover working drawings and construction documents including architectural, interior, structural, mechanical, electrical specialty theatre lighting engineering, and specialty acoustical engineering. This would bring the project to a shovel ready stage. Tim wished to know if a report would be filed after each consultation so that we have a paper copy for our records. Peter will contact Gregory for this information.

Tim recommended that ACES take the current drawings to a theatre professional and ask their opinions of the project. Helen recommended that we wait until after Stage 2 is complete to do this.

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#### 4. Presentations

**a. Town of Edson:** ACES will be making a presentation to Edson Town Council on Tuesday November 6, 7:30 pm in Council Chambers at the Town Office. ACES encourages all members of the public to attend this meeting to show their support.

During this presentation ACES will showcase the work they have completed over the past year including all the updated drawings of the new facility, as well as highlight their willingness to work with Council as the Town resolves its financial issues. In addition, ACES will also show Mr. McClung's 2013 services and fees list and officially ask for funding to cover these costs. These fees will adhere to Council's request of bringing the project to a shovel ready stage. ACES will also ask Council for direction on how to proceed further on this project.
